### Level 5

- Relevant & imaginative ideas
- Detailed descriptions
- Use of all the senses

### Level 6

- Ideas deliberately selected for interest
- Atmosphere maintained throughout
- use of techniques e.g simile, alliteration

### Level 3

- Some appropriate ideas
- Some use of adjectives

### Level 4

- Some detailed descriptions
- Relevant ideas chosen

## Organise your writing in a suitable way

### Level 5

- Ideas are organised into verses
- The ending sums up the atmosphere
- The ideas build on each other

### Level 6

- Ideas are organised into themes
- Ideas carefully sequenced to create atmosphere

### Level 3

- Ideas placed in some order
- The poem begins & ends

### Level 4

- Ideas have an opening & closing
- The ideas follow on from each other
- It looks like a poem
