2. Richard treats servants with contempt.
3. Anne is unafraid of Richard and is angry that the pall bearers are.
4. The depth of Anne's loathing for Richard.
5. Richard's ability to use high praise and religious imagery to flatter and make his intentions seem innocent.
6. Anne thinks Richard killed her husband and father-in-law savagely and without care.
7. Anne views Richard as an inhuman object.
8. Richard can twist insults to his own advantage.
9. Richard tells Anne she is a heavenly being.
10. Anne has no doubt Richard killed her husband.
11. Richard claims it was gossip that prompted him to kill Anne's husband.
12. Anne views Richard as a small animal.
13. Richard wants to sleep with Anne.
14. Richard claims it is Anne's fault he killed her husband because he is in love with her.
15. Anne does not think there is a better man than her husband.
16. Anne wishes Richard would drop dead after she spits at him.
17. Richard claims his unrequited love for Anne is sadder than anything else that has happened to him.
18. When Richard encourages Anne to kill him he does not really want her to do it.
19. Richard pretends to offer Anne a choice but it is not much of one.
20. Anne is slowly changing her mind about Richard.
