	D	Beatrice realises Eddie told on the men and accuses him directly.
	E	Eddie phones Immigration
	F	Eddie wonders if Marco has come to apologise to him.
	G	Catherine admits to Rodolfo she is afraid of Eddie
	H	Immigration officials arrive and arrest Marco, Rodolfo and the two other illegal immigrants.
	I	Beatrice tells Catherine she won't go to the wedding and Catherine reacts angrily.
	J	Rodolfo and Marco move upstairs to Mrs Dondero's apartment.

K	Marco and Eddie fight. Eddie pulls a knife but Marco turns it back and stabs Eddie with it.
L	Marco wonders if Eddie wants to apologise to him.
M	Eddie tells Rodolfo to leave but Catherine says she is leaving too.
N	Eddie tells Beatrice if she goes to the wedding she can not return to the house.
O	Rodolfo warns Eddie that Marco is coming.
P	Alfieri warns Eddie he won't have any friends if he contacts immigration about Rodolfo and Marco.
Q	Beatrice accuse Eddie of wanting Catherine for himself. Both Eddie and Catherine react with horror.
R	Beatrice tells Eddie that two more illegal immigrants have arrived upstairs and Eddie reacts with terror.
S	Marco spits in Eddie's face and Eddie threatens to kill him in revenge.
T	Eddie kisses Catherine and then kisses Rodolfo when he protests.
